

Dear Rob:

I am in receipt of your letter dated September 18, 2008 regarding discovery of information and documents concerning punitive damages. I disagree with your proposal. It is approximately 90 days before the trial of this action and given the lengths to which we have gone to get responses to substantive discovery in this action and the fact that there is no rule that punitive damages discovery must only be produced within 30 days of trial, production of the documents and information sought in our discovery requests seems appropriate at this time.

I was unable to agree to your request for an extension because of concerns in this office about the refusal of the Court to extend discovery and the possible loss of the right to move to compel if the answers were received after the discovery cut-off date by consent. Otherwise, you know I would have accommodated your request.
