



(3) Plaintiff shall have an opportunity to challenge any designation listed on the log and, in the event that a designation is challenged, Defendant Turner shall submit the log, along with the disputed document(s), to the Court for in camera inspection.

(4) At the present time, Defendant Nelda Turner is not compelled to produce the documents requested by Plaintiff in her Request for Production No. 2.

(5) At the present time, Defendant Nelda Turner is not compelled to submit her computer hard drive to Special Master Craig Ball. If Defendant Nelda Turner fails to fully comply with <sup>this</sup> order on or before May 22, 2009, Plaintiff's Second Motion to Compel Production from Defendant Nelda Turner and to Extend Authority of Special Master <sup>(will be set for)</sup> another hearing, ~~will be set~~ at which time this court will reconsider expanding the authority of Special Master Ball to include examination of Defendant Turner's computer hard drive.
